Dear Friend,

We invite you to participate in the monthly cycle of **free international webinars** on a scientific basis and applications of dynamized high dilutions (DHD) in agriculture, livestock, and the environment.

This scientific outreach project brings together scientists, producers, environmental professionals, and entities that interface with hardcore science and global society. Its goal is to create a network for exchanging experiences and incubating outreach projects involving the rational application of DHDs in agro-economics and environmental management with a view to sustainable development.

The initiative to organize these webinars is part of the activities related to the TERRA project, maintained by the "Fonds de Dotation Madeleine et Rolland Conte" - FMRC, France, whose objective is to promote research in the area and ensure that knowledge reaches where it is needed, anywhere on the planet. Highly diluted and dynamized products produce biological and therapeutic effects capable of meeting at least eight of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals defined by the UN and fit into the three prongs of the "One Health" concept (human, animal, and environmental health). Thus, these meetings envision the construction of new production matrices for a near and urgent future.

The idea is to bring together like-minded professionals organically, so **feel free to forward this invitation** to people on your contact list who are involved in an activity that fits in this context. The first meeting will be held on the Zoom platform on June 03, 2025, at 12:00h BRT or -3 GMT (17:00h CET summertime) and will repeat monthly, every first Tuesday. In the first meeting, we will discuss the details of this networking project (including participation and disclosure policies and specific dates). Due to the time zone differences between different regions, we found a comfortable time for all participants. All meetings will be in English (with subtitles also in English).
